

# Funding Options

## (How to bring Brandon to your school)

**1. Team Up with Another School:** Share Brandon with a nearby school/youth organization and save! Bookings must be during the same day. Forward a link to [www.brandonleewhite.com](http://www.brandonleewhite.com) and share your plan with the other school.

**2. Cultural Awareness Week Grant:** Depending on your theme, federal grant money might be available from organizations such as Safe and Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act (SDFSCA).

**3. Designated Funds:** Associated Student Body fund or Staff Development -- Title VI funding, are potential options.

**4. PTO/PTA:** Present your plan and they might help you fund the event.

**5. Additional Grant Money:** Contact your State Department of Human Services and State Department of Education. Find the specific department that pertains to your interest. (e.g. Alcohol and Drug Abuse Division)

**6. Local Businesses:** Ask a local business to sponsor/support the assembly. (Kiwanis, Lions Club, Elks, Rotary Club, Chamber of Commerce, etc.)

**7. Collaborate with School Clubs:** Have multiple school clubs team up in order to increase organization and effectiveness. It is also a good way to teach students about funding skills.

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
